ALL DOT ACCREDITED ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS IN REGION 1 OPERATING AS QUARANTINE FACILITIES TO OBSERVE LATEST IATF RESOLUTION REQUIRING ALL ARRIVING GUESTS TO A MANDATORY FACILITY- BASED QUARANTINE FOR THE FIRST 10 DAYS OF THE 14- DAY QUARANTINE PERIOD

The Department of Tourism (DOT) is enjoining all accommodation establishments in Region 1 operating as quarantine facilities to strictly observe and implement the new protocol pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 114 series of 2021 dated May 6, 2021 requiring all inbound travellers to undergo fourteen (14) day quarantine upon arrival. The first ten (10) days of which shall be observed in a quarantine facility, with the remainder to be completed under home quarantine in their respective local government units of destination; the RT-PCR testing shall be conducted on the seventh day with Day 1 being the day of arrival. Notwithstanding a negative test result, the arriving traveller shall complete the facility-based quarantine period of ten days.

The said resolution effective on 6 May 2021 shall continue to be enforced unless otherwise revoked.
